Thanks to the parent's responsiveness, the child understands that:

- · Language allows people to share intentions
- · There are links between words, objects or events





(gesture, gaze, babbling, crying, pointing, words, object manipulation...)



UNIVERSAL CHARACTERISTICS OF RESPONSIVENESS:

- Fast (within 5 seconds after intention)
- Consistent with what the child is interested in
- Multimodal : look, speak, manipulate, show
- Adapted to the child's level
